

Application for Exemption

Peer Passenger, One Passenger or Prohibited Vehicle Condition

This form is for P-platers who wish to have an exemption from:

- The peer passenger condition (applies to P1 drivers under the age of 25 only).
- The one passenger condition (applies to provisional P1 and P2 drivers reissued a provisional licence following a disqualification for a driving offence committed on or after 11 July 2005 only) and
- The prohibited vehicle condition (applies to provisional P1 and P2 licences issued from 11 July 2005).

Further information on these conditions is available at nsw.gov.au or in the Road User Handbook.

Completing this form

You must always complete section A, section B and sign the declaration at section C.

You must also complete:

- Section D if you are applying for a peer passenger exemption
- Section E if you are applying for a one passenger exemption
- Section F if you are applying for a prohibited vehicle exemption
- Section G if you are applying for a variation to a current exemption
- Section H if you are applying for a replacement exemption letter

The statutory declaration in section H must be completed by the registered operator(s) of a prohibited vehicle if the applicant is applying for a prohibited vehicle exemption.

Lodging this form

- This application form must be lodged at a Service NSW centre.
- If a person other than you submits the form the representative details in section C must be completed.
- An exemption from the prohibited vehicle, one-passenger or peer-passenger condition may be granted in exceptional circumstances.
- You must attach supporting documentation and provide reasons why you have an exceptional circumstance to have your exemption request considered.
- The form will be processed and the applicant will be notified in writing of the result.
- You must hold a current provisional licence to apply for an exemption.
- A fee is payable when the form is lodged and is not refundable if an exemption is not granted.

Exemption letters

If your application for an exemption is approved you will be sent an authorised Transport for NSW exemption letter. You must only drive in accordance with the exemption conditions in the letter and produce the letter to a police officer on demand. Transport for NSW may withdraw the exemption at any time.

Section D - Peer Passenger Exemption

This condition applies only to P1 drivers under 25 years of age. The peer passenger condition restricts the driver from carrying more than one passenger under the age of 21 between the hours of 11pm and 5am.

An exemption may be granted if:

- you are required as part of your employment responsibilities to transport passengers between 11pm and 5am and more than one of these passengers is, or is likely to be, under 21 years of age
- you can demonstrate a need to drive certain immediate family members between 11pm and 5am and that there are no alternative options
- you volunteer in community service work (e.g. Lifeline counselling) that requires the transport of passengers between 11pm and 5am and more than one of these passengers is, or likely to be, under 21 years of age.

If your application is for employment purposes or in connection with a community service work, **you must attach a statement** on your employer / community organisations' business letterhead. Signed by your employer or relevant person supporting your application outlining your days and hours of employment, details of work duties, name of employer/community service manager and their contact details.

Section E - One Passenger Exemption

I am applying for a:

The one passenger condition applies to P1 and P2 drivers who have been re-issued a provisional licence following a court disqualification for an offence committed on or after 11 July 2005. The condition restricts the driver from driving with more than one passenger at all times for a period of 12 months.

An exemption may be granted in exceptional circumstances such as for family or employment purposes. If your application is for employment purposes you must **attach a statement** on your employers business letterhead. Signed by your employer or relevant person supporting your application outlining your days and hours of employment, details of work duties, name of employer/manager and their contact details.

Section F - Prohibited Vehicle Exemption This condition restricts all P1 and P2 drivers, regardless of age, from driving 'prohibited vehicles'. From 1 August 2014, a prohibited vehicle is a motor vehicle which: • has a Power to Mass Ratio (PMR) of greater than 130 kilowatts per tonne · has had an engine modification is listed on the Authority's publication Novice Driver-High Performance Vehicle performance vehicle.

Restrictions as a high

An exemption may be granted to a person who can:

- · demonstrate that an exemption is required for employment purposes
- prove that they, or their parent, guardian, spouse, or partner, owned a vehicle prior to 1 August 2014, and that their vehicle was allowed under the previous definition of a high performance vehicle
- prove they owned the prohibited vehicle prior to 11 July 2005 or before an interstate/overseas licence transfer (attach proof of acquisition). Note, only a provisional driver who has never held a NSW licence before his/her licence transfer can apply for this exemption
- demonstrate any other exceptional circumstance, (attach any information necessary to support your exemption request).

Note: NSW provisional licences issued prior to 11 July 2005 were not subject to a condition. However, a provisional vehicle exemption condition will be applied if the provisional driver is disqualified for an offence committed on or after 11 July 2005. In these instances, the provisional holder may be granted an exemption if they can prove direct ownership of their current vehicle at the time of the offence that led to the disqualification (attach proof of acquisition).

An exemption from the prohibited vehicle condition will not be granted simply on the basis that the only vehicle available in a household is a prohibited vehicle.

If your application is for employment purposes, you must attach a statement on a business letterhead signed by your employer supporting your application.

The statutory declaration must be completed by the registered operator(s) of the nominated vehicle(s).
