SHIPPING WARNING
 Warning: Due to manoeuvring difficulties of large ships, no anchoring at anytime allowed within the entrance area and the entire Outer Harbour.
 Warning: No recreational craft allowed within 50 metres of Jetties 3, 4, 6, and the Flammable Liquids Berth or vessels berthed thereat, and the whole Inner Harbour area.

Caution: Wave Generator
 Keep clear at all times.

Note: It is compulsory to carry certain safety equipment, including a lifejacket type 1 for all on board, whilst navigating in the open sea. It is also compulsory that lifejackets be worn while crossing all entrance bars shown on this map.

BEFORE BOATING
 Check the weather, check the boat and its gear, tell someone where you are going.

BAD WEATHER
 Secure loose items and hatches, put on a lifejacket, report your position and consider alternate safe havens.

EPIRB
 Make sure you have a 406MHz beacon.

BOMBORAS
 Take extra care near bombies, where eddies, currents and waves can be unpredictable.
