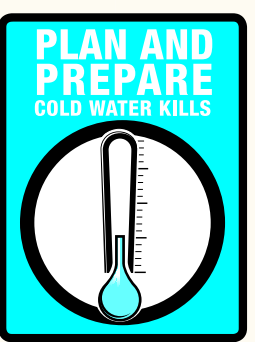
WARNING: Water in this section of
