## **Night work and extended Saturday working hours on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road at Kooragang from Monday 15 August 2016**

**The Australian and NSW governments have each committed funding for this project to improve traffic flow and cater for future traffic growth.**

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing work to duplicate 3.8 kilometres of Tourle Street and Cormorant Road between Industrial Drive, Mayfield West and Egret Street, Kooragang, including the construction of a second bridge over the Hunter River.

Upcoming work includes:

- Delivery of equipment to the construction site
- Removing existing line markings and concrete islands on the road and replacing with new line markings to provide separation between traffic and the construction area
- Installation of new signage to improve safety
- Bridge construction including concrete works near the Hunter River
- Earthwork and asphaltting activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some of the work will be carried out at night and outside standard working hours.

Intermittent night work will be carried out within the project area from **Monday 15 August**. The work will be carried out **Sunday to Friday** between **6pm** and **7am** and will continue during August and September, weather permitting.

We will also be working extended Saturday hours from **Saturday 20 August to Saturday 24 September** between **7am** and **6pm**, weather permitting.

We will continue to work **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm**, weather permitting.

### **How will the work affect you?**

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- Arranging the work in stages at different locations
  - Using the minimum amount of machinery necessary and turning off the machinery when not in use
  - Monitoring worker behaviour to ensure noise is kept to a minimum.
