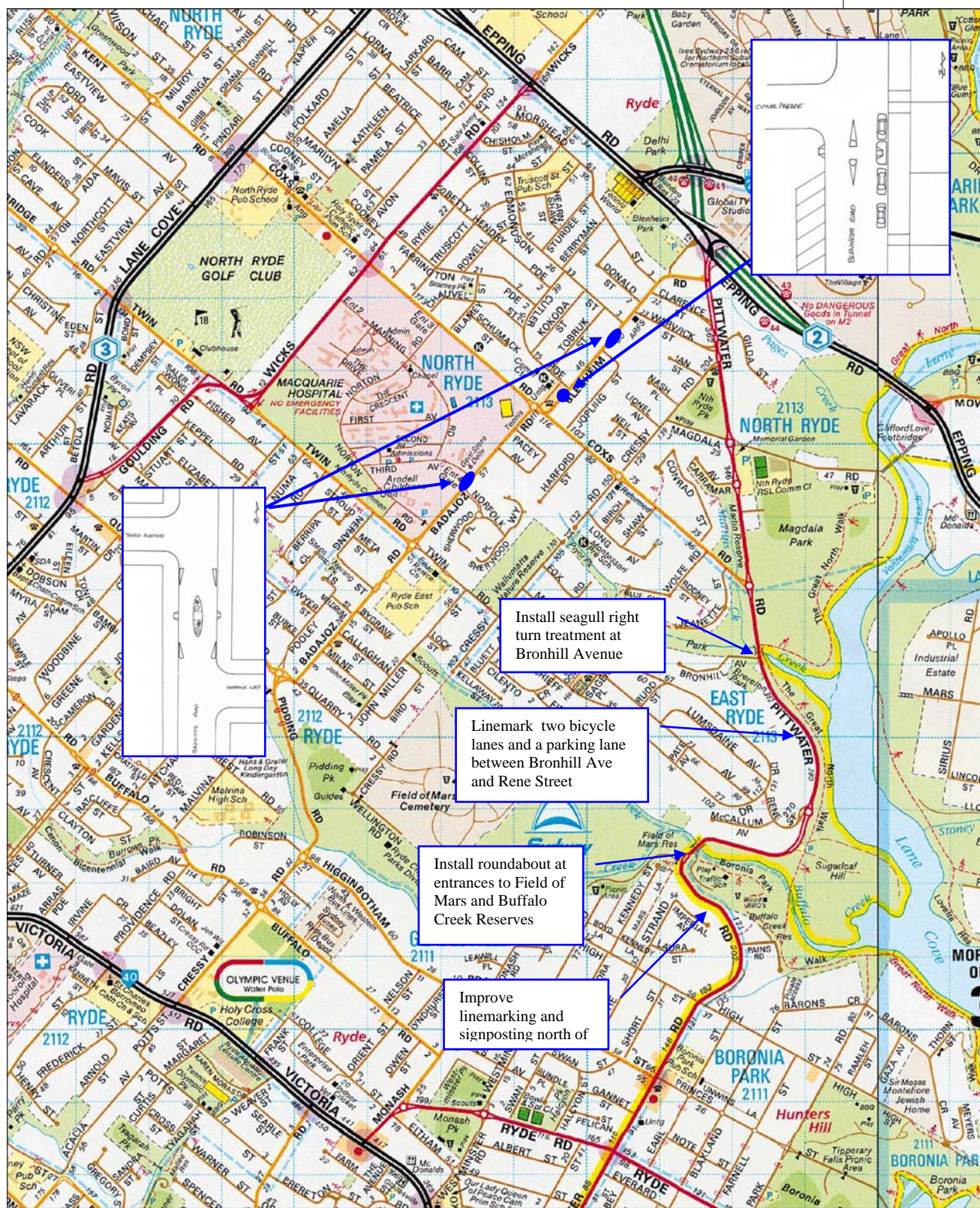


Figure 1: Draft Traffic Management Devices

<p><b>1. Welcome and Confirmation of Previous Minutes</b></p> <p><b>2. LATM Process Flowchart</b> Refer to handout on the LATM Planning and Approval Process.</p> <p><b>3. LATM Options and Discussion</b> Figure 1 attached describes the draft LATM treatments and their location.</p> <p><b>Pittwater Road</b> A number of treatments recommended for Pittwater Road by the 1998 Traffic Management Study prepared by Project Planning Associates have not been installed. It is proposed that these would assist with management of traffic flow.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Install seagull right turn treatment at Bronhill Avenue</li> <li>• Linemark two bicycle lanes and a parking lane between Bronhill Ave and Rene Street</li> <li>• Install roundabout at entrances to Field of Mars and Buffalo Creek Reserves</li> <li>• Improve linemarking and signposting north of Pains Road</li> </ul> <p><b>Badajoz Road</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Install a central tadpole incorporating pedestrian refuge north of Norfolk Way</li> <li>• Install a pedestrian refuge south of Cutler Parade at shopping strip.</li> </ul> <p><b>Blenheim Road</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Install a central tadpole incorporating pedestrian refuge north of Jopling Street</li> </ul> <p><b>Quarry Road, Twin Road, Coxs Road and Wicks Road</b> Monitor traffic conditions after tunnel opens and consider the need for further treatment.</p> <p><b>4. Actions from Previous Meeting</b> See above.</p> <p><b>5. Other Matters</b></p> <p><b>Outline of the public exhibition process</b> Separate brochures for the 4 areas will be prepared with draft schemes. Display panels will be placed in Council offices. One out-of-hours venue will be arranged for each council area. Internet information to be available. There will be a 4 to 6 week exhibition period.</p> <p><b>Format for the questionnaire</b> The questionnaire is proposed to include an Agree/No opinion/Disagree question for each proposed treatment. This will provide statistical results. Residents may also provide further written comment as an attachment.</p> <p><b>6. Next meeting</b> TBA</p>
