



Application to Change Vessel on Mooring

IMPORTANT

To change a vessel on a Private Mooring Licence the applicant **must**:

- Be the registered owner of the vessel to be attached to the mooring.
- Be aware that the vessel must be at least 5.2 metres in length, unless otherwise approved by Roads and Maritime Services.
- Understand that a change of vessel application will only be granted 'subject to approval' and will be assessed on the proposed vessel size, type and condition.
- Provide a recent photograph of the vessel intended to be attached to the mooring.
- Provide Proof of Identity (POI). For further information visit rms.nsw.gov.au/maritime or phone **13 12 36**.
- Pay the prescribed fee. If you submit the application by mail or email, **do not send credit card details** - Roads and Maritime will contact you for payment.
