

Managing traffic and improving safety around the University of Wollongong

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out temporary traffic management for the start of the university year.

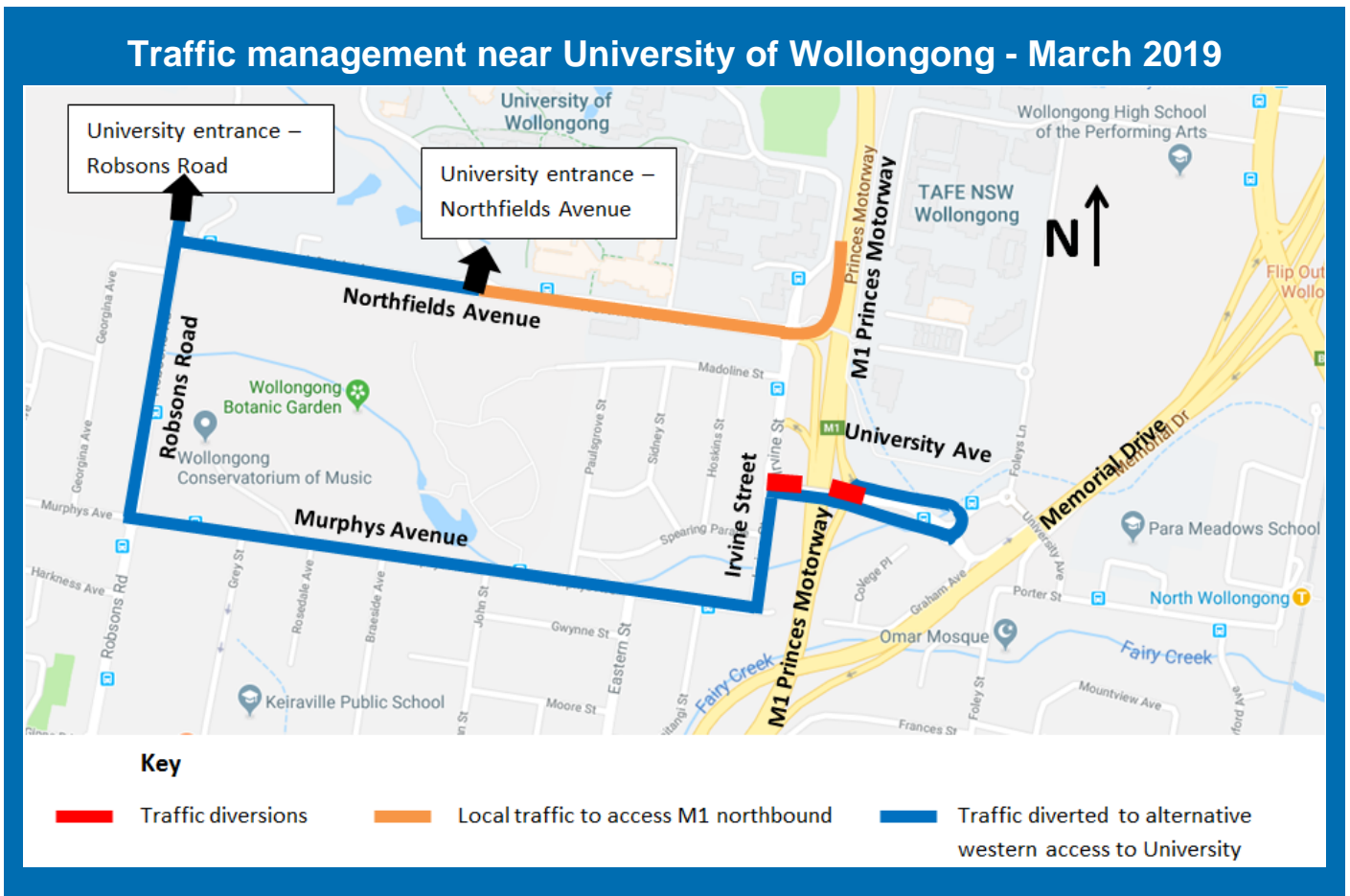
We will be monitoring traffic queues on the M1 Princes Motorway and when required divert traffic onto the existing University Western Access alternative route during peak periods from **Monday 4 March for three weeks.**

We expect that traffic will be diverted between **8.15am and 8.45am from Tuesday to Thursday,** based on information from previous years.

We will continue to monitor traffic flows around the University however it is expected that congestion will reduce by late March.

Benefits include:

- reducing queues along the M1 approaching the University exit ramps
- improving safety for motorists on the M1
- reducing traffic congestion and providing safer conditions for road users living near and travelling to the University of Wollongong.



How will this affect you?

Residents may observe additional traffic travelling along Murphys Avenue and Robsons Road during peak periods.

Outside peak periods traffic will continue to access the University via Irvine Street and Northfields Avenue.

Residents will have access to their properties at all times.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank the community for their patience while we carry out this important work.



Temporary traffic changes

Traffic controllers will monitor traffic flow at key locations between 8am and 9am from Monday to Friday.

If traffic queues form along the M1, traffic controllers will divert all westbound traffic on University Avenue left into Irvine Street to access the University via Murphys Avenue and Robsons Road.

Traffic will not be diverted unless queueing occurs along the M1.

Bus access from University Avenue into Irvine Street will not be affected during diversions.

Traffic heading towards the University from the M1 northbound will not be diverted.

Motorists wishing to access the M1 northbound ramp (towards Sydney) at Northfields Avenue during these peak periods will be diverted via Murphys Avenue and Robsons Road.
