Chiswick Wharf upgrade

Temporary wharf closure from Wednesday 1 February and some early morning and night work between Sunday 12 February and Friday 10 March 2017.

As notified in the recent Community Update, as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program, work to upgrade Chiswick Wharf and interchange will start on **Wednesday 1 February 2017**. The wharf will be closed for about five months, weather and maritime conditions permitting. All efforts will be made by the project team to reopen the wharf as soon as possible.

Work to install piles for the new wharf will be carried out soon after the closure of the wharf. This will require some early morning and night work over a number of days **between Sunday 12 February and Friday 10 March 2017**. Pile installation requires calm water conditions, which usually occurs in the early hours of the morning when wind is low and there are fewer boats on the river.

Some piling work, including drilling and hammering of piles, can be noisy. Night work will take place between 11pm and 7am. Every effort will be made to minimise noise levels, with hammering work restricted to between 5am and 7am on weekdays. Hammering will be intermittent, with one minute periods of hammering occurring five times per hour.
