



Have your say - Maritime Heritage Precinct Marina

The NSW Government is proposing to construct a marina next to the Australian National Maritime Museum in Pyrmont Bay to showcase the largest collection of historical maritime vessels in the Southern Hemisphere.

Roads and Maritime Services is seeking your feedback on the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) for the Maritime Heritage Precinct Marina from **28 January to 1 March 2019**.

The proposed marina consists of two new wharves, pontoons and a small vessel facility. This would bring together historical maritime vessels in one place and will showcase the operational vessels of the Sydney Heritage Fleet for the enjoyment and education of the general community, preserving Australia's maritime story and historical connection to the water.
