

Start of site management work at the former Rozelle Rail Yards from Monday 21 August 2017

The NSW Government is funding this project to improve the former Rozelle Rail Yards.

Roads and Maritime will be starting work to clean up the former Rozelle Rail Yards site, which is overgrown and derelict from years of disuse from **Monday 21 August**. Roads and Maritime has appointed Fulton Hogan Construction Pty Ltd to carry out this work, which will take around 12 months to complete.

Early work activities to establish the site will include:

- inspection and improvement of fencing and gates
- installation of a weigh-bridge and wheel-wash facilities
- installation of temporary site offices and signage
- construction of access routes and gates within the site
- start of property condition inspections, utilities identification and survey
- site clearing including weed spraying and vegetation removal
- sampling and testing, cleaning up and removing stockpiles of older items and materials.

Hours of work

Work will start from **Monday 21 August 2017** and take around 12 months to complete. The early work activities described above will take around six weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be **Monday to Friday** between **7am and 6pm**, and **Saturday** between **8am and 1pm**. No work will be done on Sundays or public holidays.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times, and will continue to keep the community and stakeholders updated as work progresses.

How will the work affect you?


During the day you may notice increased noise and truck movements associated with the work as we start to move onto site.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by carrying out the work in stages at different locations across the site.

Traffic

Vehicle access during the early work will be mainly via James Craig Road, Rozelle for large vehicles and Lilyfield Road/Gordon Street for light vehicles. Once this work is complete large vehicles will access the site via City West Link Road.
