The NSW Government is funding a project as part of its \$246 million Pinch Point Program, which aims to reduce delays, manage congestion and improve travel times on Sydney’s major roads, particularly during weekday peak periods.

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading the intersection of Boundary Street at the Pacific Highway and Corona Avenue, including widening Boundary Street to help improve traffic flow and safety for road users.

## Project update

Roads and Maritime have established a site compound in the north eastern corner of the Roseville Chase oval carpark, and completed most of the utility adjustment work, stormwater improvements and road widening on Boundary Street east of Hill Street. We have also progressed utility adjustments and road widening west of Hill Street. Work still to be done includes:

- Additional utility adjustments along Boundary Street and Pacific Highway
- Further road widening on Boundary Street west of Hill Street.

## Our work schedule

We will continue working up to **five nights a week**, including some **weekends** until mid-2017. Our **night work** hours will be between **8pm** and **5am**, with less noisy construction work between **midnight** and **5am**. We will also be working from **7am** to **6pm** between **Mondays** and **Fridays** and from **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays**.

## How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times but we will continue to do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**.

## Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes

We have reopened the southbound left turn lane from Pacific Highway onto Boundary Street. There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
