

Closure of footpath at north-west corner of Warringah Road and Ferguson Street from 4 April to 2 May 2018

The NSW Government has completed the pedestrian bridge across Warringah Road at Starkey Street, Forestville.

Following the opening of the Starkey Street pedestrian bridge and new bus stop, Roads and Maritime Services will now remove the old bus stop on the western side of Ferguson Street. Safely removing the bus stop requires the closure of a section of the footpath at this location.

The footpath will be closed from **Wednesday 4 April** until **Wednesday 2 May**, weather permitting.

The work will include:

- carrying out footpath work
- completing landscaping
- removing the old bus stop.

During the work, there will be two nights of low noise night work to complete line marking and kerb and guttering. This night work will take place from **8pm to 5am** on **Monday 9 April** and **Tuesday 10 April**, weather permitting.

The work will also include a week closure of the pedestrian crossing at Ferguson Street from **Thursday 5 April** to **Wednesday 11 April**.

The closure will ensure there is minimal risk to workers and pedestrians while the work is carried out. Full pedestrian access will be reinstated when the work is complete.

A temporary pedestrian crossing will be set up on Ferguson Street north of Walkom Avenue, or pedestrians can continue to use the pedestrian signals at Darley Street.

A map of pedestrian detour options is included in this letter.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy and there may be some disruption associated with this work including vehicle movements and changes to access. Machinery and equipment used during the work may include small excavation equipment, concrete trucks, hand tools, hand tools and light vehicles.

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact to the local community.

We thank the community for their patience as work was carried out in this area.

Traffic changes


