

## Project update – Night work on Heathcote Road, Engadine

**The NSW Government is jointly funding this project as part of the \$300 million Gateway to the South Program and the NSW Safer Road Program to improve road safety.**

Roads and Maritime Services sought feedback from the community and stakeholders in March 2017 on a proposed night work construction schedule for work on Heathcote Road, Engadine.

We have included a map to show the location of the work.

The project involves:

- adjusting the road surface, between 1.3 kilometres and 2.3 kilometres north of the Princes Highway, Engadine
- removing and replacing sections of asphalt
- installing new signs
- replacing guardrail
- painting road markings.

We received feedback from five people, three supporting the proposed schedule, one supporting the alternative schedule, and one that did not identify their preference. We have responded directly to feedback.

After considering feedback received, we have decided to proceed with the proposed schedule, working up to **five nights** a week for **six weeks**. However, following recent investigations, additional work has been identified in this project's scope which will extend the project to **nine weeks**.

We thank everyone for considering the proposal.

### Additional work

Additional work is required to improve safety and stabilise the slope along Heathcote Road, including removing trees and vegetation, concrete work, drainage and maintenance repairs. This work will take a further three weeks to complete in addition to the proposed schedule.

Carrying out this additional work would allow us to complete the project as quickly as possible to minimise the disruption period for the local community and road users.

Work is planned to start in June 2017.

### How will the work affect you?

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.


