


End of work: Heathcote Road intersections at Engadine and Lucas Heights

Upgraded intersection of Heathcote Road and Princes Highway, Engadine



Work is complete on improvements to Heathcote Road's intersections with Princes Highway, Engadine, and New Illawarra Road, Lucas Heights.

Heathcote Road serves Sydney's southern and southwestern suburbs, as well as Wollongong, the Illawarra and South Coast.

Around 20,000 vehicles pass through the Heathcote Road and Princes Highway intersection

every day, while 3000 road users pass through the Heathcote Road and New Illawarra Road intersection every hour during daily peak periods

At the Princes Highway intersection, the improvements aimed to address delays caused by a lack of right-turn capacity from Heathcote Road and by queueing left-turn traffic.

At New Illawarra Road, the upgrades aimed to improve traffic flow onto Heathcote Road.

What the work involved

- Relocating utilities, constructing new kerbs and installing new traffic lights and street lighting.
- Widening Heathcote Road on its approach to Princes Highway.
- Adding a dedicated right turn lane from Heathcote Road onto Princes Highway.
- Widening New Illawarra Road on its approach to the Heathcote Road intersection.
- Constructing new left and right turn lanes from New Illawarra Road onto Heathcote Road.
- Road resurfacing and linemarking.
