

Heathcote Road Intersection Improvements

Project Update | December 2018



Work under way at Heathcote Road and New Illawarra Road, Lucas Heights

The NSW Government is delivering improved journey reliability on Sydney's key southern corridors.

Road and Maritime Services is working to ease congestion and improve travel times on Heathcote Road by upgrading two key intersections.

This includes providing additional right and left turn lanes from New Illawarra Road onto Heathcote Road, and providing an additional right turn lane and maintaining the existing left slip lane on Heathcote Road at the intersection with Princes Highway.

We anticipate this work will be completed by the end of February 2019, weather permitting.

Key benefits

The project will ease congestion at these two busy intersections and improve travel time reliability. It will also improve safety for road users and help reduce the number of crashes.

What happens next?

The final work required for the project includes:

- Road resurfacing, final asphalt work and line marking
- Removing temporary traffic barriers and signals
- Landscaping.

Work to date

Since our last project update in October 2018 we have completed:

- Utility relocation
- Demolishing and constructing kerbs
- Pavement construction for road widening
- Modifying median islands
- Tree trimming
- Installing and adjusting traffic lights and relocating signs.

Our work schedule

To complete work we will be on site for up to **six days a week for 48 shifts**. Weekday shifts will be between **7am and 6pm**, and between **8am and 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

We will also work up to **five nights a week for 40 shifts**, between **8pm and 5am** from **Sunday to Thursday**, weather permitting.

We will not work from **Monday, 24 December 2018** to **Sunday, 6 January 2019**. Work will start again on **Monday, 7 January 2019**.

Work will not be carried out on public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including working in different locations and completing the noisier activities by **midnight**.


