

Intersection improvements on Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown

Project update

The NSW Government is delivering easier, faster and safer travel on Sydney's busiest roads

Stage one: Stacey Street widening

Roads and Maritime Services is widening Stacey Street between Macauley Avenue and Stanley Street to provide three lanes in the southbound direction for road users. We are also extending the existing dual right turn bay on Stacey Street for road users turning right into Macauley Avenue. This will deliver improved traffic flow and travel reliability, connecting motorists to southern Sydney, the Sydney CBD and Sydney's west more easily.

Footbridge closure

Due to safety concerns for people who use the footbridge over the storm water culvert on Stacey Street directly opposite Petunia Avenue, it will be **closed permanently from Wednesday 31 October 2018** as part of this project.

A safe alternative crossing using traffic lights is located 200 metres away at the Macauley Avenue intersection.

Our work schedule

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturdays, 9pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Wednesday** and **10pm** and **5am** on **Thursday**.

We have completed temporary road pavement work, removed and replaced line marking and installed concrete barriers to allow us to start work on the shoulder between Salvia Avenue and Petunia Avenue to prepare for the new third lane.

Our work in the next few months will include:

- installing a new third lane
- installing new stormwater drains and new kerb and guttering.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact. We will perform noisy work throughout the day wherever possible, and finish all noisy work by midnight where night work is essential.

Traffic changes

There will be some traffic impacts for road users and pedestrians. Road users and pedestrians are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to these changed traffic conditions.

We will maintain two lanes of traffic in both directions throughout the project.
