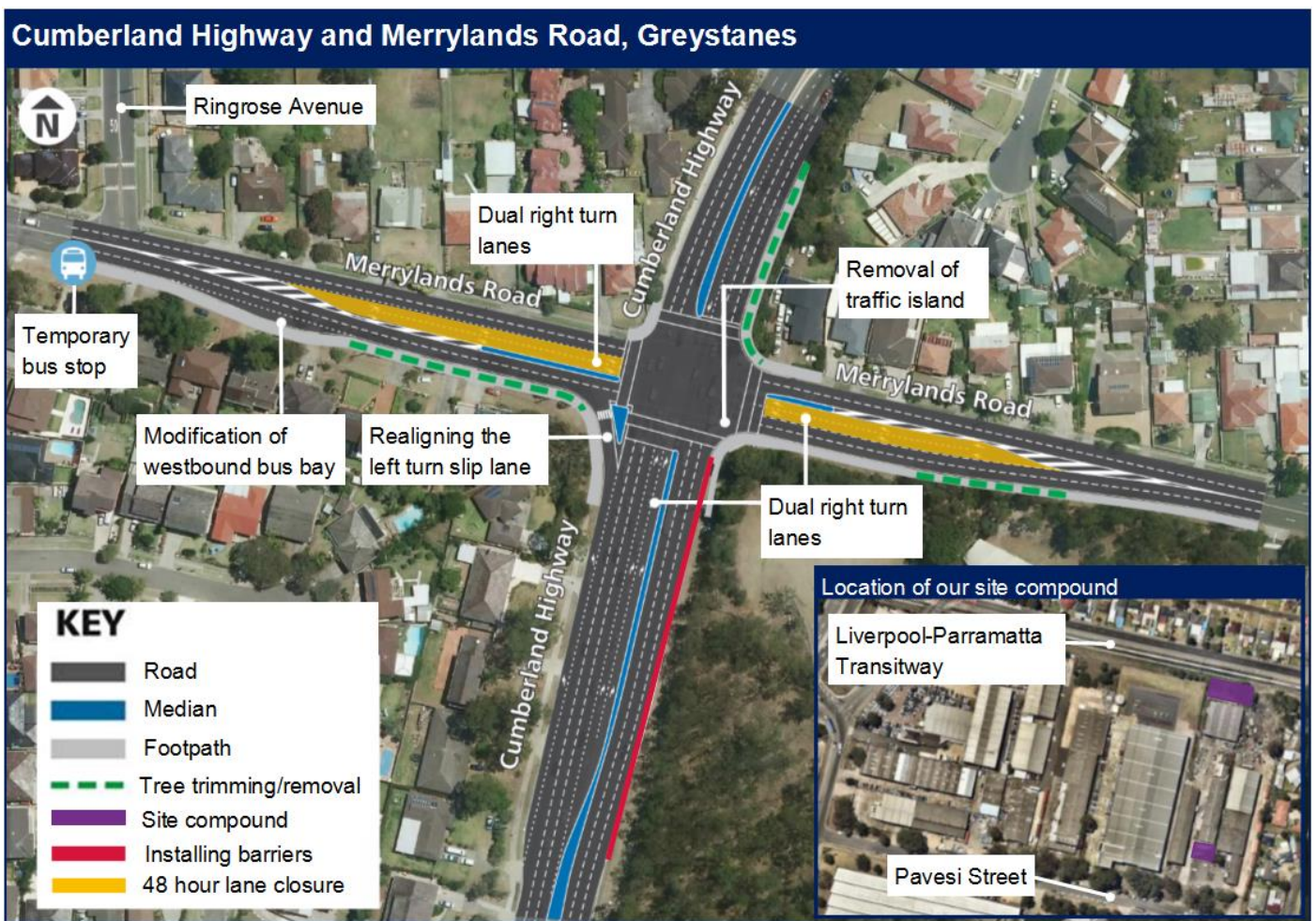


Intersection improvements on Cumberland Highway and Merrylands Road, Greystanes

Roads and Maritime Services | December 2018

The NSW Government is investing in this work as part of its program to ease congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.



Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading the intersection of Cumberland Highway and Merrylands Road, Greystanes. The work will reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times on Sydney's road network.

Progress so far and the next stage

We have completed the site compound setup, removed existing medians on all approaches, temporarily moved the westbound bus bay, removed vegetation and adjusted the footpath, driveways and kerbs.

The next stage of work includes:

- Installing dual right turn lanes east and westbound on Merrylands Road and northbound on Cumberland Highway
- Installing barriers along Cumberland Highway on the south-east corner of the intersection
- Adjusting the central road medians on all approaches of the intersection to accommodate the new turning lanes
- Realigning a left turn slip lane on the Cumberland Highway to accommodate the new intersection layout
- Adjusting the existing traffic lights for more efficient travel through the intersection
- Landscaping work.

Asbestos

During construction we have identified undisturbed asbestos at this site. We are implementing an asbestos management plan that details safe work practices and we will ensure asbestos finds continue to be managed to strict Environment Protection Authority requirements. The asbestos will be managed to ensure there is no risk to the public.

Our work schedule

Construction will continue until **mid-2019**, excluding public holidays and weather permitting. Our work hours will be between **8pm and 5am from Sunday to Friday, 7am and 6pm on weekdays and between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.**

Work will stop during the holidays from Saturday 22 December to Friday 4 January.
