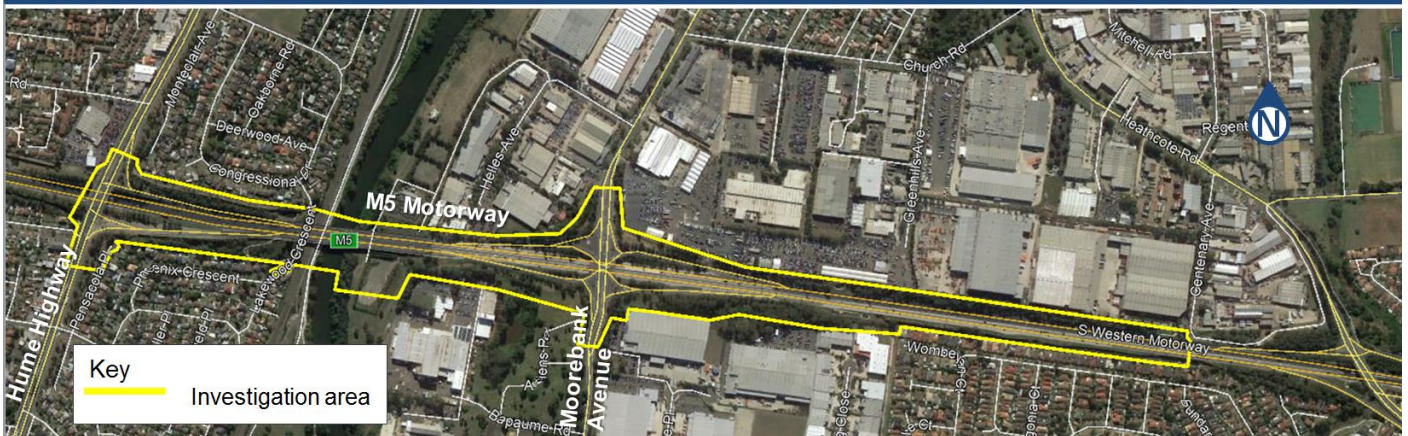


Day and night work on M5 Motorway, Hume Highway and Moorebank Avenue from Tuesday 13 August 2019

In planning for potential road upgrades, we are conducting investigation and survey work in the local area.

Location of work on the M5 Motorway, Moorebank



Roads and Maritime Services will carry out essential geotechnical, utility investigations and survey work on the M5 Motorway between Heathcote Road and The Hume Highway, Moorebank.

The investigation work will be carried out between **Tuesday 13 August** and **Friday 25 October 2019**, weather permitting. Work during the day will occur on weekdays between **7am** and **6pm** and on Saturday between **8am** and **1pm**.

Additionally, night work will be carried out for up to **20 night shifts** during this period. Work during the night will occur on weekdays between **9pm** and **5am** with noisier work completed before **11pm**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact.

We will schedule the work in stages at different locations so residents will not be affected for more than two consecutive nights per week.

Traffic changes

During the night work, lane closures will take place on the M5 Motorway, Hume Highway, Moorebank Avenue and Lakewood Crescent. Traffic control and a reduced speed limit will be in place for the safety of workers, motorists and pedestrians.
