

Project update for traffic and road improvements on Parramatta Road, Granville to Lidcombe

The NSW government is funding this \$1.8 million project to improve traffic flow and safety along Parramatta Road between Church Street, Granville and Birnie Avenue, Lidcombe.

Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback in December 2016 on traffic and road improvements on Parramatta Road to help ease traffic congestion and improve the consistency of travel times for motorists, particularly during peak periods.

We received feedback from three people raising six different matters.

We have summarised the feedback and our responses to it in a community consultation report, which is available on rms.nsw.gov.au/projects or from our delivery partner Ventia Boral Amey Joint Venture on nswenquiries@vbajv.com.au.

After considering all responses, we have decided to proceed with the proposal unchanged. We have responded directly to questions or concerns raised and thank everyone for considering the proposal.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **30 shifts** between **Friday 3 February** and **Sunday 14 May**, excluding **public holidays**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be from **9pm** to **5am**.

The work includes:

- Removing the right turn lane westbound into Alban Street
- Removing a through lane westbound between Kendall Street and George Street
- Extending right turn lanes into Lidcombe Shopping Centre and Day Street South
- Removing pedestrian crossings across Parramatta Road to improve traffic flow out of Macquarie Road and installing pedestrian fencing at the intersection
- Removing three parking spaces on the eastern side of Alban Street, four parking spaces at the intersection of Parramatta Road and Macquarie Road and 12 parking spaces on Birnie Avenue to improve traffic flow
- Relocating a bus stop about 35 meters further south of the intersection of Parramatta Road and Hampstead Road
- Removing and replacing asphalt and adjusting line marking
- Removing and adjusting concrete medians
- Installing and adjusting signs
- Changing traffic lights and installing sensors.

We have included a map to explain the locations of the work.

How will the work affect you?

The work will noisy at times but we will make every effort to minimise its impact, including completing noisier work by **midnight** and staging work in different locations.

Access to some properties may be affected during shift hours but traffic controllers will be on hand to make sure you can enter and leave as required. Access to bus stops may also be affected, but traffic controllers will direct you to temporary stopping points nearby. Street parking in sections of the work zone will also be unavailable during shift hours.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and detours will be in place and may affect travel times. Access to Parramatta Road from some side streets may be restricted during the work. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
