

## Project update for traffic and road improvements on Parramatta Road, Homebush

### The NSW government is funding this \$1.8 million project to improve traffic flow and safety along Parramatta Road between Bridge Road and Knight Street, Homebush.

Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback in December 2016 on traffic and road improvements on Parramatta Road to help ease traffic congestion and improve the consistency of travel times for motorists, particularly during peak periods.

We received feedback from three people raising six different matters.

We have summarised the feedback and our responses to it in a community consultation report, which is available on [rms.nsw.gov.au/projects](http://rms.nsw.gov.au/projects) or from our delivery partner Ventia Boral Amey Joint Venture on [nswenquiries@vbajv.com.au](mailto:nswenquiries@vbajv.com.au).

After considering all responses, we have decided to proceed with the proposal unchanged. We have responded directly to questions and concerns raised and thank everyone for considering the proposal.

### Our work schedule

We will be on site for **20 shifts** between **Friday 3 February** and **Sunday 9 April**, weather permitting. Our work hours will be from **9pm to 5am**.

The work includes:

- Adjusting line marking
- Installing and adjusting signs
- Removing a small concrete median on Underwood Road
- Removing five parking spaces on Underwood Road on approach to Parramatta Road to improve traffic flow
- Removing three parking spaces on Bridge Road on approach to Parramatta Road to improve traffic flow.

We have included a map to explain the location of the work.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier work by **midnight** and staging work in different locations.

Access to some properties may be affected during shift hours but traffic controllers will be on hand to make sure you can enter and leave as required. Access to bus stops may also be affected, but traffic controllers will direct you to temporary stopping points nearby.

Street parking in sections of the work zone will also be unavailable during shift hours.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and detours will be in place and may affect travel times. Access to Parramatta Road from some side streets may be restricted during the work. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
