

Temporary solar lighting on Camp Street Bridge, Forbes, from Wednesday 13 March

Power will be disconnected and temporary solar lighting will be installed on Camp Street Bridge to maintain pedestrian and road safety.

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out the work, which includes installing temporary solar lighting on Camp Street Bridge.

We will be working between **7am** and **6pm** from **Wednesday to Friday** and expect to complete the work in **three days**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic control to ensure the work zone is safe.

On **Wednesday 13 March**, lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.
