

# Camp Street Bridge replacement

Community update – June 2018



Visualisation of the new bridge

Roads and Maritime Services is planning to replace the Camp Street Bridge over Lake Forbes to improve safety for road users and help reduce future maintenance costs. Roads and Maritime invites you to provide feedback on the Review of Environmental Factors (REF) by **Friday 27 July 2018**.

## Project overview

The Camp Street Bridge was built in 1927 and is narrow, in poor condition and nearing the end of its life. A new bridge is needed to meet current design standards and improve safety for motorists and pedestrians into the future. The project involves building a new, wider bridge across Lake Forbes with wider travel lanes and pedestrian/cyclist paths.

The design includes landscaping suitable to the surrounding lakeside environment. The lamp posts from the existing bridge will be incorporated in the design to complement the town's heritage aesthetics. An animated visualisation of the new bridge and surrounds can be viewed on the project webpage.

## Review of Environmental Factors

The REF has been prepared to assess the potential impacts of the proposal and actions to reduce them.

The REF found that the proposal would not significantly affect the environment or the community with the application of identified mitigation measures. The proposal's concept design was displayed for community feedback in October 2017. We thank the community for your feedback which has been considered in preparing the REF.



## Project phases




