

Rawsonville Bridge maintenance, Rawsonville Bridge Road

The NSW Government is delivering a stronger and longer lasting bridge. To carry out the work safely it is proposed to close the bridge for up to six months.

Project update

Roads and Maritime Services has been carrying out maintenance on Rawsonville Bridge, west of Dubbo for the past six months.

Inspections have identified two bridge supports must be replaced to ensure its continued safe operation.

To carry out the work safely we are proposing to close the bridge for up to six months. The pier replacement work is proposed to be carried out in late 2019.

Project benefits

The key benefits of the work include:

- Improved safety for road users
- Stronger, longer lasting bridge
- Reduced ongoing maintenance costs.

Upcoming work

Work proposed to take place from late 2019 includes:

- Removing two bridge supports
- Building new foundations and replacing the two piers
- Installing rock protection on the banks of the river near the bridge.

Temporary traffic changes

There would be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work area is safe.

During the proposed six month closure, traffic would be diverted via Burraway Road, adding up to 20 minutes to travel times.

Signage would be in place to direct traffic.


