## Final touches to the Alford's Point Road upgrade from Monday 6 November

### The NSW Government has almost completed the \$40 million project to improve safety and traffic flow on Alford's Point Road between Georges River and Brushwood Drive

Roads and Maritime Services will finalise the Alford's Point Road upgrade by completing minor asphalt work on the southern bridge abutment during **three shifts of night work** between **Monday 6 November** and **Sunday 12 November**. Our working hours will be from **7pm to 5am**.

#### How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise where appropriate. Every effort will also be made to focus the light only on the working area, however there may be some spill-over of light into nearby residences.

#### Changes to Brushwood Drive on-ramp Give Way

The change to the Give Way intersection on the Brushwood Drive on-ramp to Alford's Point Road took place on **Tuesday 10 October**. Roads and Maritime have engaged a consultant to monitor and review the traffic queues and safety performance of the change over the next **three months**. At the end of this period, the consultant will prepare a report with a recommendation for the permanent configuration. We will work with Sutherland Shire Council to select and implement the permanent configuration.

#### Removal of the speedbump on Brushwood Drive

The temporary speedbump on Brushwood Drive was installed as part of the strategy to highlight the change in give way arrangement. In consultation with Sutherland Shire Council, the notification period is now over and the speedbump will be removed on **Monday 6 November** to further improve the performance of the new intersection, weather permitting. The traffic monitoring of the intersection will use the new data to provide an informed recommendation.

We ask that you still take care at the intersection, as motorists get used to the changes.

#### Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes and lane closures will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for motorists and workers.
