Intersection improvements Parramatta Road at Arlington Street, Five Dock and Croydon Road, Croydon

Start of work | October 2020

The NSW Government is delivering intersection improvements that will reduce delays for bus customers and motorists as part of the NSW Governments Bus Priority Infrastructure Program.

From late October 2020 work will commence at the intersection of Parramatta Road, Arlington Street and Croydon Road, Five Dock and Croydon.

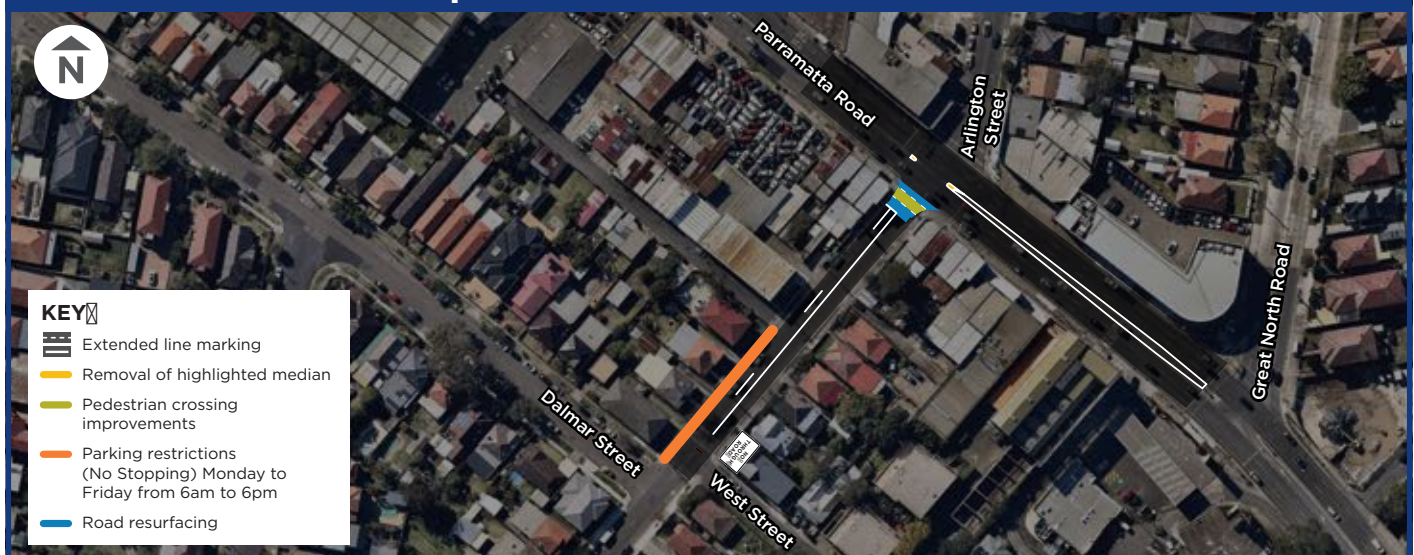
What we are doing?

- Remove the existing concrete median on Parramatta Road, westbound
- Trim the existing concrete median on Parramatta Road, eastbound
- Changing the existing AM & PM peak timed parking along Croydon Road to No Stopping from **6am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**
- Concreting new kerb and pram ramps
- Road resurfacing and line marking
- Remove and re-instate existing bus stops to new locations.

Key benefits

- Improved lane use by extending the lane line marking further along Croydon Road, allowing buses to enter a lane well before the intersection with Parramatta Road
- Improved turning paths for all vehicles joining Parramatta Road from Croydon Road and Arlington Street
- A more efficient approach to Parramatta Road along Croydon Road with parking restrictions (no stopping) on weekdays from **6am to 6pm**
- Clearer line marking on Croydon Road to help vehicles stop before the pedestrian crossing at Parramatta Road.

Our work schedule

Due to high traffic volumes in the area, a majority of construction work for this project will be carried out at night. We will be on site for seven night shifts between **late October** and **late November 2020**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am, Sunday** to **Thursday**. We will not work public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities, such as saw-cutting and jack hammering by midnight.

Traffic changes

There may be temporary traffic changes during our night work hours to ensure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
