Project update

August 2018

The Australian and NSW Governments are continuing to deliver the Belmore Road ramps project to improve access to and from the M5 South-West Motorway at Riverwood for local residents and businesses.

Work is progressing well on the project, which will provide two new east-facing ramps at Belmore Road, Riverwood to allow direct access to the M5 South-West Motorway. Work is expected to be completed in early 2019.

What's happening next?

Over the next three months we will be:

- continuing to build the new drainage at Bonds Road
- continuing work to upgrade Belmore Road including relocating utilities and upgrading the central median
- starting work to widen the existing eastbound off ramp
- starting earthworks to prepare the ground for the new eastbound ramps
- starting to build new drainage for the new eastbound ramps.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. For safety reasons, a reduced speed limit of 80 km/hour is in place on the M5 South-West Motorway while the work takes place.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy and include extra lighting, however we will do everything we can to minimise its impact including completing noisier work earlier in the evening and directing lights away from residential areas.

Our work schedule


Our work hours will continue to be from **7am to 6pm** between **Mondays and Fridays**, and from **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Our night work hours are from **8pm to 6am** between **Mondays and Sundays**. Night work will be intermittent and no night work will be carried out on Friday or Saturday evenings or on public holidays.

Work to date

Since work started in April 2018 we have:

- set up the site compound
- removed vegetation to make a pathway for the new ramps
- started work to upgrade the central median on Belmore Road
- started to relocate utilities on Belmore Road
- started construction of the new drainage at Bonds Road.
