Berry to Bomaderry Princes Highway upgrade – final stages of relocating electrical service utilities

The NSW Government is funding this \$450 million project to improve traffic flow and road safety on the Princes Highway between Mullers Lane, Berry and Cambewarra Road, Bomaderry.

Roads and Maritime Services is at the final stages of relocating utilities before major construction of the Berry to Bomaderry upgrade begins.

Impacts to power supply at some properties to complete utility relocations

Endeavour Energy has been engaged by Roads and Maritime to relocate electrical utility services in preparation for major construction of the Berry to Bomaderry upgrade to start.

Work is planned to start on Saturday 2 June and continue until August 2018 between Cambewarra Road, Bomaderry and Croziers Road, Berry.

There will be impacts to power supply at some properties. You will receive a notice from Endeavour Energy notifying you if your property will be impacted.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic stoppages from Saturday 2 June when utility relocation work is being carried out near the highway. These stoppages are for the safety of workers and motorists and may affect travel times by up to five minutes.

For the safety of workers, the speed limit between Mullers Lane, Berry and Cambewarra Road, Bomaderry has been reduced to 80km/h.
