

Night work on the Princes Highway between Meroo Meadow and Jaspers Brush from 31 March

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be re-locating safety barriers on the Princes Highway between Pestells Lane, Meroo Meadow and Strongs Road, Jaspers Brush from **Tuesday 31 March** to **Thursday 2 April 2020** weather permitting.

Work crews will start setting up from 6pm and our work hours will be between **7pm** and **5am** to minimise the impact to motorists on the Princes Highway.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with this work, but we will make every effort to minimise disruption by completing noisier work in the first half of the night where possible. The work will involve the use of cranes, excavators, forklifts, lighting towers, heavy and light vehicles as well as hand tools.

Traffic changes

One lane will be closed on the Princes Highway at works sites during work hours and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h in place for the safety of workers and motorists. Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
