Berry to Bomaderry upgrade, Princes Highway update

On behalf of Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) thank you to all the community members who attended the recent focus group meetings and provided valuable feedback.

Meetings were held on 1, 3 and 10 May 2012, 7 June 2012, and a specific meeting to discuss the proposed heavy vehicle rest area and enforcement bay on 21 June 2012.

Residents discussed the design of the proposed upgrade and shared their opinions and ideas at these meetings. Issues raised by local residents are now being investigated by RMS. An issues register based on community comment and feedback is now available to view on the project website.

Next steps

The draft concept design will be refined over coming months, giving consideration to the issues raised by the community. During this time RMS is preparing an environmental impact assessment of the proposed upgrade. This assessment is called a review of environmental factors (REF).

Some property owners may be asked to provide access for environmental specialists to conduct investigations. Affected property owners will be contacted direct to ensure permission for access and to minimise any disruption.

RMS expects the final concept design and REF will be ready for public comment in mid 2013. In the meantime there will more community discussions on matters in the issues register such as the proposed heavy vehicle rest area.
