Foxground and Berry bypass - additional 900 metres to be built as part of bypass project.

The NSW Government is funding this \$580 million project to improve road safety and traffic efficiency. Completion is expected mid 2018.

Roads and Maritime Services will extend the project area of the Foxground and Berry bypass to the south, providing motorists with a further 900 metres of upgraded highway. This additional section will be built as part of the current work without increasing the construction period for the bypass.

Accelerating the upgrade of this section of highway will not only provide a further 900 metres of upgraded highway at an earlier time but will also provide safety benefits for both workers and motorists when the future construction work for the Berry to Bomaderry upgrade is underway.

The additional section of divided highway will include two lanes in each direction between Andersons Lane and 150 metres north of Croziers Road, Jaspers Brush and is based on the approved concept design for the Berry to Bomaderry Princes Highway upgrade.

The temporary u-turn bay at Croziers Road will also be used for this construction work. Roads and Maritime is continuing to investigate access arrangements at the intersection of the Princes Highway and Croziers Road, Jaspers Brush.

We will be working during standard working hours between 7am and 6pm, Mondays to Fridays and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

We will make every effort to minimise noise. During construction you can expect:

- Traffic control to be in place on the Princes Highway between Andersons Lane and Croziers Road, for the safety of motorists and workers. A reduced speed limit will be in place.
- Relocation of services such as water, electricity and telephone cables. The provider will let you know if there will be any interruption to your service.
- Tree and shrub removal.
- Machinery and vehicles movements on site such as excavators, graders and vibratory rollers.
- Construction vehicles using the temporary u-turn facility on Croziers Road.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
