

Changed traffic conditions between Mullers and O’Keeffes Lanes, Berry to Bomaderry upgrade

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be moving traffic onto a new section of road on the eastern side of the highway between Mullers and O’Keeffes lanes at Jaspers Brush this month.

This will require four nights of preparation work between 9–13 December (weather permitting) including relocating of barriers, asphaltting and line marking ahead of moving traffic onto a new section of road.

The change will also include a new, temporary access to Croziers Road.

The temporary traffic change will allow the project team to begin work on the existing northbound carriageway and the permanent Croziers Road intersection.

How will the work affect you?

Work will be carried out between 7pm and 5am to minimise impact to motorists on the Princes Highway. There will be some noise associated with the work however the project team will endeavour to complete noisier activities earlier in the night to minimise impacts to residents.

Traffic changes

Traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers’ directions. For the latest traffic updates call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com, or download the Live Traffic App.
