

Changed traffic conditions on Princes Highway at Ison Lane and Strongs Road, Jaspers Brush

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

We will be carrying out road surfacing, line marking and barrier relocation at the intersections of Ison Lane, Strongs Road and near Flying Fox Creek bridge from **Thursday 11 June**, for up to two nights (weather permitting). The work is in preparation for traffic to switch onto new intersections at these locations from **Friday 12 June**

Work will be carried out between **6pm** and **5am** to minimise the impact to motorists.

Should the work need to be postponed, new dates will be advertised on variable message signs and on the project website.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and light associated with this work. Work will include the use of lighting towers, cranes, road surfacing machinery and heavy vehicles.

For the safety of motorists and our workers there will be lane closures, stop/slow traffic control and 40km/h speed limits in place.

From **Friday 12 June**, motorists will use the new Ison Lane intersection, about 100 metres north of the existing intersection. The new Strongs Road intersection, about 50 metres south of the existing intersection will also be open at this time. Diagrams of these changes are provided on the following page.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
