

## Changed traffic arrangements at Lamonds Lane

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

### What are we doing?

The Berry to Bomaderry project is preparing to move traffic onto newly constructed sections of highway between Ison Lane and Abernethys Lane in October 2020. When this takes place, there will be changed access arrangements to a number of local roads, including Lamonds Lane.

### How will the work affect you?

From **Monday 5 October**, temporary access to Lamonds Lane will be via the newly constructed Devitts Lane highway entry/exit ramp and underpass as shown in the diagram on page two. Motorists will then travel south along the old highway alignment to access Lamonds Lane.

This temporary access arrangement will be in place for up to **four weeks** while a new direct highway access is constructed at the intersection of Lamonds Lane and the Princes Highway.

Please note that following completion of the intersection, access will return to normal.
