

Changed traffic arrangements at Silos Estate entrance and Ison Lane

The NSW Government is upgrading the Princes Highway between Berry and Bomaderry to improve safety, increase road capacity and improve traffic flow.

What are we doing?

The Berry to Bomaderry project is preparing to move traffic onto newly constructed sections of highway between Ison Lane and Abernethys Lane in October 2020. When this takes place, there will be changed access arrangements to a number of local roads, including Silos Estate entrance and Ison Lane.

How will the work affect you?

From **Wednesday 7 October**, drivers will be moved onto the newly constructed sections of the highway. As part of these changes, access to Silos Estate and Ison Lane will be directly from the new highway.

Ison Lane will have a temporary dedicated southbound right-hand turn lane, while a widened southbound shoulder at Silos Estate will allow through traffic to safely pass a right turning vehicle.

Vehicles exiting south from Silos Estate will be required to turn left onto the Princes Highway to access the newly constructed u turn facility and right turn lane located 900m north of Silos Estate.
