

Work re-starting at Blaxland Road and First Avenue, Eastwood from 24 October

The NSW Government is working to ease congestion, increase safety and improve travel times at the intersection of Blaxland Road and First Avenue, Eastwood, as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Points Program.



Roads and Maritime Services is widening First Avenue around Ryedale Road to lengthen the left hand turn bay from First Avenue onto Blaxland Road.

We are also changing the lane markings on Blaxland Road to create a second right turning lane onto First Avenue.

This project began in January and was scheduled to be completed at the end of November 2019. However, we have experienced some delays and now expect to finish work in March 2020.

Our work schedule

We will be working for up to **five nights a week for 50 shifts** between **Thursday 24 October** and **Friday 27 March 2020**, weather permitting. We will not work on public holidays.

Our work hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**, **Saturday between 8am and 1pm** and between **6pm and 7am Sunday to Friday**.

Progress so far

We have relocated a number of utilities and modified the existing concrete medians.

Over the next few months we will:

- finish relocating the utilities
- extend the left hand turn lane on First Avenue
- complete asphaltting
- finalise line marking and installing sign posts.

How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise and disruption associated with this work including project vehicle movements, concreting and earthmoving equipment and construction.

We will make every effort to minimise noise and disruption. We will complete noisier tasks by midnight. We will also ensure we schedule some nights completely free of work to give residents respite from any prolonged night work.

We will not be working over the Christmas and New Year break, with a planned shutdown between Saturday 21 December 2019 and Sunday 5 January 2020.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.
