## Project background

We are currently investigating initiatives to improve the transport network along the existing road corridor in Bulli and Thirroul.

This forms part of our long term commitment to provide safe, efficient and reliable journeys through Bulli and Thirroul while maintaining the character and amenity in the town centres.

We are seeking feedback on your experiences travelling in and around the Bulli and Thirroul town centres, and how this experience might be improved in the future.

The study area includes the Princes Highway and Lawrence Hargrave Drive from Hospital Road in Bulli to Mary Street in Thirroul, excluding Bulli Pass.

## Project objectives

Bulli and Thirroul are experiencing increased traffic volumes and demand for access to local centres and services.

We are investigating key constraints and issues in the study area including on-street parking, traffic queuing and delays in peak periods.

Our current investigations will identify options to:

- reduce travel times
- improve road safety
- maintain the amenity of both town centres.
