

Frequently Asked Questions

Bulli and Thirroul Improvements

Road and Maritime Services is seeking feedback on traffic, safety, and public transport options along the Princes Highway at Bulli and Lawrence Hargrave Drive at Thirroul

What is the project about?

We are currently investigating initiatives to improve the transport network along the existing road corridor in Bulli and Thirroul.

This forms part of our long term commitment to provide safe, efficient and reliable journeys through Bulli and Thirroul while maintaining the character and amenity in the town centres.

What is the study area?

The study area includes the Princes Highway and Lawrence Hargrave Drive from Hospital Road in Bulli to Mary Street in Thirroul, excluding Bulli Pass.

What is the focus of the investigation?

We are investigating key constraints and issues including on-street parking, traffic queuing and delays in peak periods.

This current investigation will identify options to:

- reduce travel times
- improve road safety
- maintain amenity of both town centres.

Is Roads and Maritime planning to introduce clearways in Bulli and Thirroul?

Clearways can help manage congestion by allowing motorists to use all available lanes during peak periods. They could form part of a broader solution for Bulli and Thirroul.

Will parking spaces be reviewed as part of this investigation?

We are carrying out parking surveys to understand the number, location and customer use of existing parking in Bulli and Thirroul.

Could improvements to public transport assist in reducing congestion?

Feedback and suggestions about changes or improvements to public transport will be considered by Roads and Maritime. Your feedback will help inform future transport solutions.

How will Roads and Maritime consider improvements to connections for cyclists and pedestrians?

We will work closely with Wollongong City Council and key stakeholders to consider opportunities to encourage walking and cycling in the area to help reduce the demand for car trips.

Does this project include a plan for a bypass of Bulli, or options to improve Bulli Pass?


The project aims to identify improvements along the existing road corridor in the study area only, and does not include the consideration of a bypass of Bulli or options to improve Bulli Pass.

Is there any funding for future work?

Once we identify options, we will bid for funding to further develop and deliver these solutions.
