Field investigations night work, Camden Valley Way to Brooks Road, from 1 October

This work is part of the NSW Government's proposed 5.4 kilometre future upgrade of Campbelltown Road, between Camden Valley Way, Casula and Brooks Road, Denham Court.

To progress design work for the proposed upgrade, Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out geotechnical investigations that include digging test pits, drilling boreholes, collecting samples for laboratory testing, taking photographs and clearing weeds to provide access tracks north of the bridge over the Hume Highway.

As part of these investigations night work will be carried out near the Ingleburn Garden Drive and Campbelltown Road intersection between 8pm and 5am from Wednesday 1 October to Monday 13 October, excluding Saturdays and Sundays, weather permitting

Changed traffic conditions

Road users are asked to follow the direction of traffic controllers, adhere to reduced speed limits and follow traffic signs. There may be minor traffic delays as a result of this work.

To minimise any noise or other impacts associated with this work we will:

- Shroud noisy equipment such as generators
- Ensure lighting is directed away from residences, where possible.
