

Intersection improvements at Canterbury Road and Bexley Road, Campsie

Project update

Roads and Maritime Services | November 2018



The NSW Government is delivering improvements at this intersection to ease congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's key corridors.

High volumes of traffic currently travel through the Canterbury Road and Bexley Road intersection at Campsie, particularly during the morning and afternoon peak periods.

Work is being carried out to widen Bexley Road and extend the right turn lane.

Key benefits

- Reduced congestion and improved safety at the intersection
- By extending the northbound right turn bay from Bexley Road to Canterbury Road
- Minimising delays by improving traffic flow through the intersection
- Improving safety of the intersection by reducing the number of rear-end crashes and crashes involving motorists changing lanes.

Work to date

Since work started in June 2018 we have:

- Installed signs and barriers
- Finished locating underground services
- Completed surveying activities and tree removal.

What's happening next?

- Night work will continue along Canterbury Road and Bexley Road
- Power poles will be moved to enable the widening of Bexley Road
- Existing footpaths, kerbs and fences will be removed to allow for the start of services relocation
- New stormwater drains will be installed
- Overhead power lines will be moved
- New road surface and kerbs will be constructed and new line markings painted.

Our work schedule

Between **November 2018 to April 2019**, we will be working **five nights** and **six days a week** weather permitting.

Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday to Thursday**. Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**.

We will not be working on public holidays or during the Christmas and New Year break from **Monday, 24 December 2018 to Tuesday, 8 January 2019**.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and speed reductions will be in place for **one weekend in February 2019**.

During that weekend our working hours will be from **9pm Friday to 5am Monday**, weather permitting. Traffic management and signs will be in place to assist motorists with the changed conditions.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although temporary detours may be in place.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including staging activities in different locations and completing the noisier activities by midnight.
