

Project update—Chandos Street Noise Wall on the Warringah Freeway, Crows Nest

The NSW Government is proposing to install a noise wall along the Warringah Freeway between St Thomas' Rest Park and Brook Street, Crows Nest. The proposal is part of the NSW Government's Noise Abatement Program and will reduce traffic noise levels for nearby residents.

Proposed works

Located on the south-west side of the Warringah Freeway, the noise wall will be about 270 metres long. The proposed noise wall will provide noise mitigation for properties in compliance with the Roads and Maritime Services Noise Abatement Program.

The geotechnical and site investigation work is complete and a concept design of the wall has been developed. If approved, the noise wall construction will take place in mid-2019.

We have included a map to show the location of the proposed noise wall.
