## Chandos Street Noise Wall



Earlier this year we wrote to you about the new Chandos Street Noise Wall we are building between St Thomas' Rest Park and Brook Lane at Crows Nest, to help reduce traffic noise for you. We are now planning to start building this noise wall early next month.

This project update provides information on what you can expect during construction, and who to contact if you require further information. We have partnered with DM Roads (our independent delivery partner) who will build this wall on our behalf, and you are welcome to contact either of our teams to discuss this work further. # The Chandos Street Noise Wall construction program




## Temporary traffic and pedestrian changes

We will need to implement some temporary traffic changes to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and workers while we build the new noise wall. We are planning to:

- Temporarily close part of the left turn lane on the Brook Street off ramp. You will still be able to turn left and right into Brook Street
- Temporary use of parking at the end of Chandos Street for construction access
- Close the walkway near Matthew Lane and the corner of St. Thomas' Rest Park during construction. Alternative access is available via Atchison Street and Matthew Lane and we will reinstate the walkway after the noise wall is complete.

We may need to temporarily interrupt access to private properties during construction. If this is required we will contact you before any access disruptions and ensure you can enter and exit your property with minimal inconvenience.

## How will our work affect you?

The landscape of the area and traffic on the Warringah Freeway makes the noise wall challenging to build. We will do our very best to minimise impacts to you and your family, but there will be some short term impacts like temporary traffic changes, night work and associated noise.

To minimise the impact of noise we have refined the design to build the wall faster and are proposing to close one lane of the Brook Street off ramp, allowing us to carry out more work during the day.

If you have personal circumstances requiring additional respite, from any construction impacts, please contact our team.

We will also need to remove some trees and vegetation in the construction area. We know trees and vegetation are important to your community, so we will retain as many trees as we can and will landscape along the alignment using similar trees.



## Our work schedule

We expect it to take around 10 months to build the new noise wall, weather permitting. Feedback your community provided us late last year indicated a preference to carry out work five nights a week and up to 60 nights so we can get the noise wall built as quickly as possible.

### We are proposing to work:

- **Between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**
- **Between 8am and 1pm Saturdays and,**
- **Between 8pm and 5am Sunday to Friday.**

No construction work will be carried out on public holidays.
