Cremorne Point stair upgrade Stairs reopening Thursday 22 September

The new Cremorne Point stairs will open on Thursday 22 September 2016.

The stairs connecting Milson Road and Cremorne Reserve have been upgraded to improve pedestrian access to Cremorne Point Wharf as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program.

The upgrade involved the removal and replacement of the existing stairs between Cremorne Point Reserve and the harbour foreshore. We apologise for the longer than expected closure period due to unexpected ground conditions. This required adjustments to the project design to ensure the stability of the new stairs and maintain the proposed landing area close to the wharf.

We thank you for your patience during the construction of the new stairs and apologise for any inconvenience.
