Community update

Intersection of Minore Road and Newell Highway, Dubbo

The NSW Government is funding a \$12 million upgrade to the Newell Highway in West Dubbo to provide a stronger and longer lasting road. The work will be carried out in two stages.

Project update

The Newell Highway in West Dubbo is in poor condition and will be replaced with a stronger, longer lasting road capable of handling the increased freight movements and heavy vehicle traffic expected on the Newell Highway in the future.

Roads and Maritime Services commenced work on Stage One of the upgrade, between Golf Links Creek Bridge and north of Minore Road in early April 2019. We expect to complete the work in eight weeks.

What you need to know

Due to the complexity of the project, we will be working a combination of days and nights until the end of June 2019.

Please refer to the Variable Message Sign (VMS) boards located at the project for more information on the work times coming up.

The work includes:

- removing the current road surface
- building a new stronger road
- installing new drainage systems
- improving the Minore Road intersection
- new line marking

Stage Two of the project, between Minore Road and Baird Street will be completed in the coming years.

Temporary traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work area is safe.

During the work, temporary lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place. Motorists should allow up to ten minutes additional travel time.

Noise

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

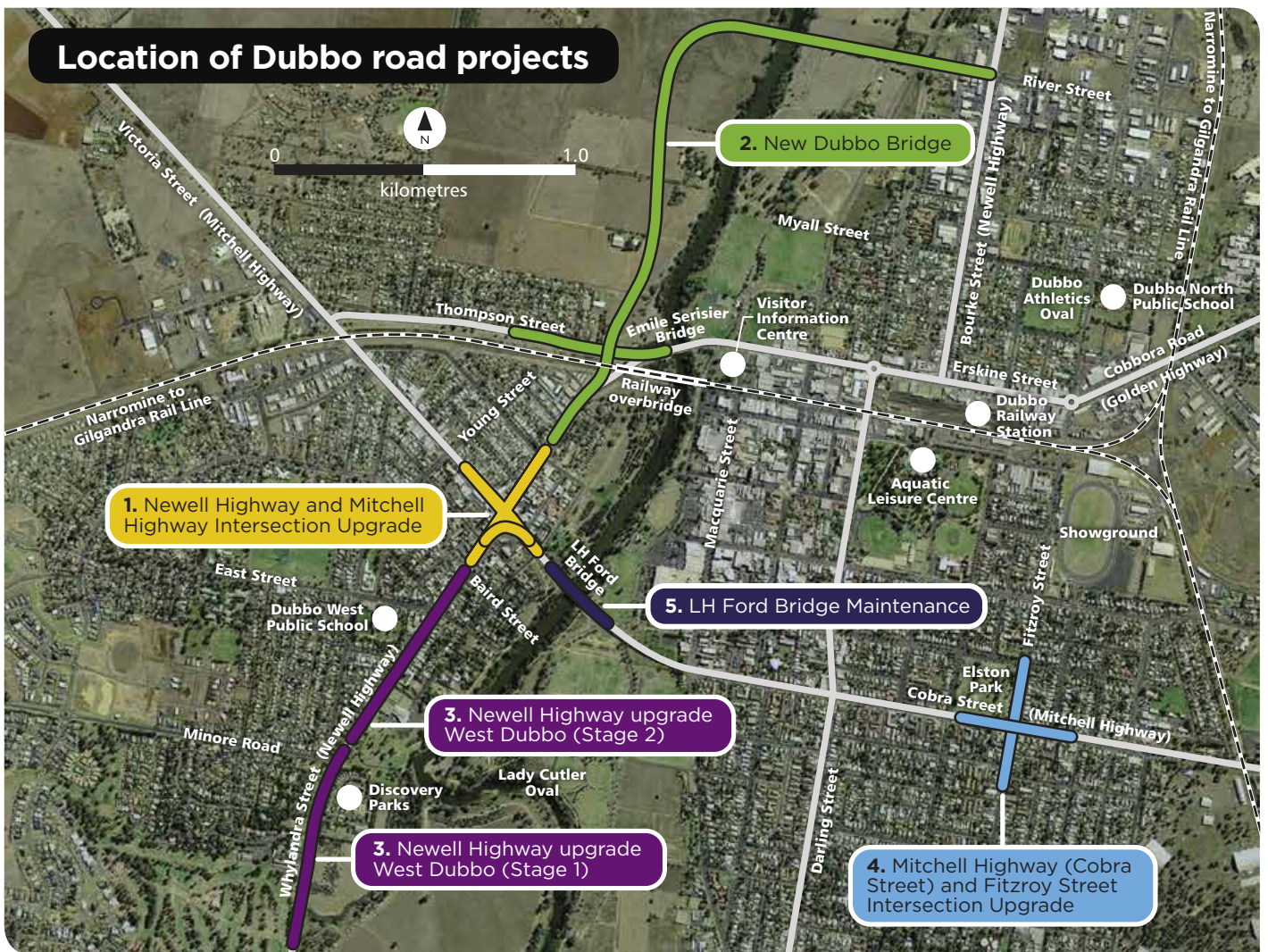
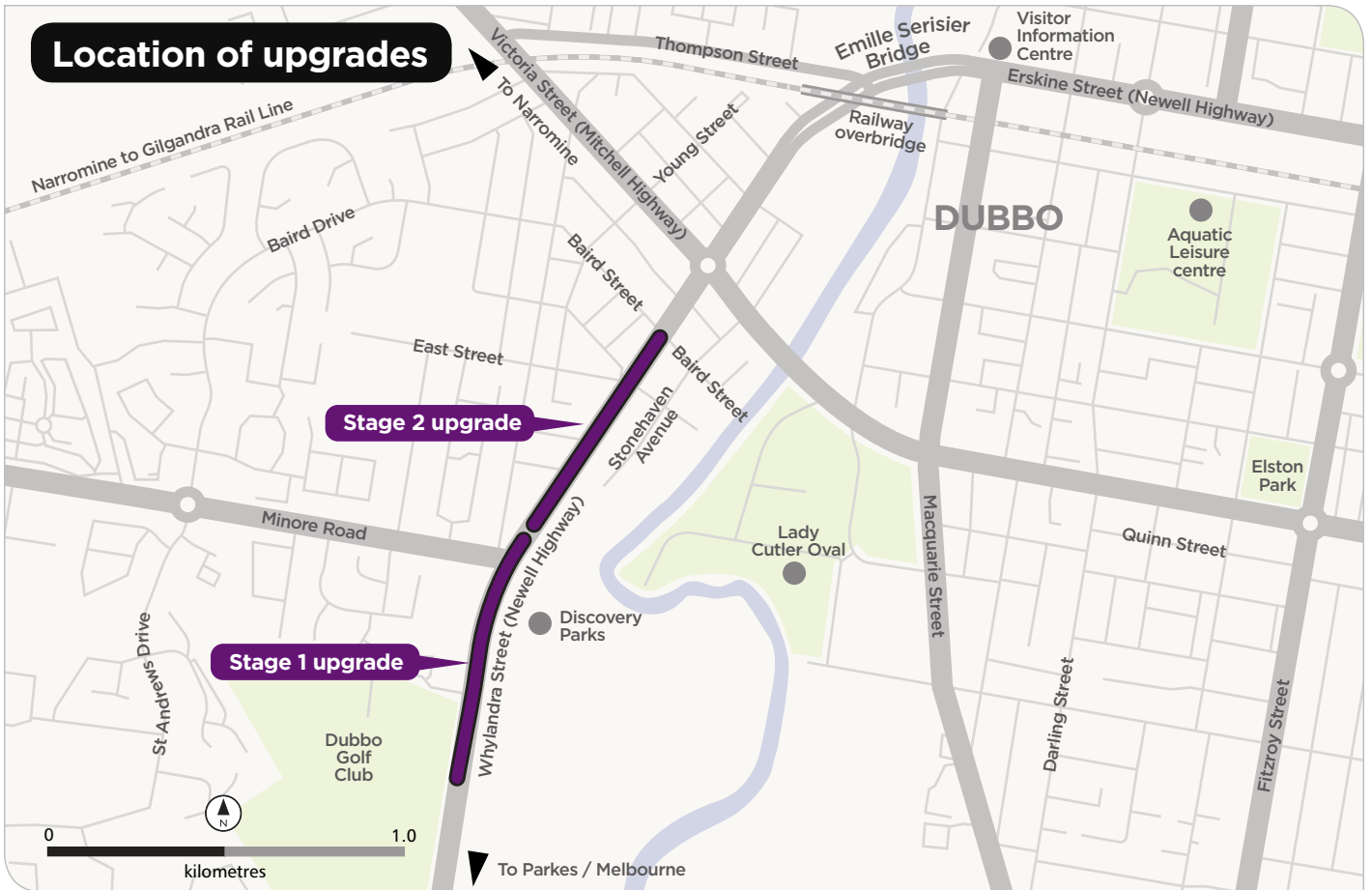
Property Access

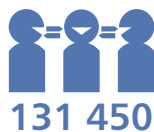
