

Bus zone extension works on General Bridges Crescent, Daceyville

Roads and Maritime Services | December 2019

The NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program is improving the reliability and efficiency of bus services, while easing congestion for all road users.

On **Monday 16 December** Roads and Maritime Services will be extending the bus zone on General Bridges Crescent, Daceyville between Bunnerong Road and Banks Avenue by about six metres further west.

Background

This bus zone is used as a bus layover location for buses to wait and start on time for their next service. During these short stops drivers remain with their buses.

The proposal has been developed by Roads and Maritime Services and Transport for NSW, in consultation with Bayside Council and bus operators.

We invited the community and stakeholders to provide feedback on this proposal in October 2019.

No major concerns were raised in relation to the proposed bus zone extension. We engaged with Bayside Council and they have no objections to the changes.



What's happening?

Work to extend the bus zone will occur on **Monday 16 December**, weather permitting.

The work involves the removal and relocation of an existing sign.

The works will be carried out during the day between 10am to 2pm.

Extending the current bus zone to allow for two longer buses to layover at the same time between services will support bus reliability and future demand for bus services in the broader area.
