

## Intersection upgrade on Eastern Valley Way, Castlecrag from Sunday 14 April

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering this project as part of its commitment to improve road safety for pedestrians and motorists.



Roads and Maritime has listened to resident concerns and will upgrade the intersection of Eastern Valley Way and Edinburgh Road, Castlecrag to improve safety. The intersection upgrade includes a new dedicated right turn arrow from the eastern side of Edinburgh Road into Eastern Valley Way northbound and changes to parking availability near the intersection.

### Upcoming night work

We will complete this intersection upgrade in two stages and will take a total of **20 night shifts**. During the first stage we will be working up to two nights a week between **Sunday 14 April** and **Friday 26 April**, weather permitting, excluding public holidays. During the second stage will be working for up to **five nights a week** between **Sunday 28 April** and **Friday 24 May**, weather permitting.

Our work hours for both stages will be between **8pm** and **5am**, Sunday to Friday.

## Our work schedule

We will be working up to **five nights a week** for **20 shifts** between **Sunday 14 April** and **Friday 24 May**, weather permitting.

We will not be working on public holidays.

Our work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

## Consultation

In February 2018, Roads and Maritime engaged with the local community to hear feedback on a proposal to create an extra lane on Edinburgh Road to accommodate dedicated right turn traffic lights into Eastern Valley Way. This included permanently removing six parking spaces on the northern side of Edinburgh Road and placing restrictions on 26 spaces on the southern side of Edinburgh Road.

We received 87 written responses from businesses, residents and other stakeholders, verbal feedback from 10 businesses and 22 residents along Edinburgh Road, as well as two petitions.

The key matters raised included safety at the intersection of Edinburgh Road and Eastern Valley Way, whether the proposal would affect the “village” amenity of Castlecrag, the effect of parking changes near businesses and removing parking near residents.

## Decision

After consulting with residents and businesses, Roads and Maritime has revised our original proposal to upgrade the intersection. The right turn lane currently on Edinburgh Road will be made a dedicated right turn traffic light phase and the left lane will be used for through traffic and left turns.

We have also reduced the number of parking spaces required to be removed or restricted during peak periods. Only 11 parking spaces will be restricted during the weekday morning peak time and 15 parking spaces during the weekday afternoon peak. No parking spaces will be permanently removed.
