

Temporary closure of Cochrone Street, Kincumber from Friday 27 September

The NSW Government is investing \$20 million to upgrade the Empire Bay Drive and The Scenic Road intersection to improve traffic flow and safety for road users.

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading the existing roundabout at Empire Bay Drive, The Scenic Road and Cochrone Street at Kincumber to provide two lanes in each direction, to reduce congestion and improve safety.

Work is continuing to be carried out between **7am** and **6pm** on weekdays and between **8am** and **1pm** on Saturdays, weather permitting.

In order to progress the work, residents and motorists are advised that Cochrone Street will be closed near the Empire Bay Drive roundabout between **6pm on Friday 27 September** and **5am on Monday 30 September**. We have included a map below to show the location of the closure.

The closure is required to safely connect the relocated sewer main to the existing sewer main, which is located deep down in the middle of Cochrone Street.

Work to be carried out includes:

- Installing safety barriers and signs near the Empire Bay Drive intersection
- Installing a new sewer man hole and pipes in Cochrone Street near the intersection of Empire Bay Drive
- Repairing the road surface and removing safety barriers to reopen Cochrone Street on Monday morning.

To complete the work in the shortest amount of time and to minimise disruption to the community, work will be carried out day and night between **6pm on Friday 27** to **6pm on Saturday 28 September** and **8am on Sunday 29 September** to **5am on Monday 30 September**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing the work in stages and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Motorists should use Kerta Road and Hawke Street to enter Cochrone Street and use Kerta Road to exit the industrial area during the temporary closure.

A permanent 40 km/h reduced speed limit remains in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers.
