

F6 Extension Stage 1 – Geotechnical investigations

The NSW government is progressing with the development of the F6 Extension Stage 1 between the New M5, Arncliffe and President Avenue, Kogarah.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out geotechnical investigation work to gather information about the ground conditions within the project area. Our advisors have selected several sites between Arncliffe and Kogarah. We have included a map to show the approximate location of the investigation work in Bicentennial Park, Kogarah.

The investigation work will start **from Monday 8 January** and will be completed by **Monday 15 January, 2018** (weather permitting). The work will take place between **7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday** and on **Saturdays between 8am and 1pm, excluding public holidays**. The work will take about one week to complete.

How will the work affect you?

Temporary fencing will be in place for the duration of the investigations, to ensure that the work zone is safe.

The work includes drilling a borehole and extracting soil samples using borehole drilling equipment. We will also be installing a groundwater monitoring sandpipe in one of the investigation locations, to monitor ground conditions over the next six months. The groundwater sandpipe will not impact the use of the playing fields.

The work requires light vehicles and a trailer mounted generator. Heavy vehicles will not be used.

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will do everything we can to minimise its impact, and we will try to minimise the disturbance to the local community.

Traffic changes

There will not be any traffic changes or changes to footpath access associated with this work.
