

F6 Extension Stage 1 – Ground condition investigations

The NSW government is progressing with the development of the F6 Extension Stage 1 between the New M5, Arncliffe and President Avenue, Kogarah.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out investigation work to gather information about the ground conditions within the project area. Our advisors have selected several sites between Arncliffe and Kogarah. We have included a map to show the locations of the investigation work closest to you.

Work will start from **Monday 18 December** and continue until **Friday 22 December 2017**, weather permitting. The work will take place between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday**. Work will take around one day to complete at the following locations:

- Rockdale Bicentennial Park, Rockdale
- on the northern and southern sides of President Avenue between Civic Avenue and O'Neill Street, Rockdale and Kogarah.

How will the work affect you?

The work requires the drilling of holes using borehole drilling equipment to extract soil samples. The holes will be about five metres deep. We will also be installing shallow groundwater sandpipes and gas wells in five of the investigation locations, to monitor ground conditions over the next six months. The groundwater sandpipes and gas wells will not impact the use of the playing fields.

To carry out the work, light vehicles, drilling rigs and a trailer mounted generator will be in use. Heavy vehicles will not be used.

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will do everything we can to minimise its impact, and we will try to minimise disturbance to the local community.

Traffic changes

There will not be any traffic changes or changes to pedestrian access to footpaths associated with this work.
