


Road work on Bridge Street at Forbes from Tuesday 14 April

The NSW Government is funding \$12.8 million to replace the Camp Street Bridge to provide a stronger, longer lasting bridge.

Road work on Bridge Street at Forbes



As part of the Camp Street Bridge replacement, Forbes Shire Council, on behalf of Transport for NSW, will be carrying out road work on Bridge Street. During the work, pedestrian access across Bridge Street near the bridge will be closed and will re-open when work is complete.

We will be working from **Tuesday 14 April** and work is expected to take about **four weeks** to complete.

Work hours will be between **7am** and **5pm Monday to Friday** and between **7am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Property access for Bridge Street residents between Hill Street and Flint Street, will be maintained via Flint Lane.

There will be no pedestrian or vehicle access to any part of the work area. Residents will not be able to cross to the other side of Bridge Street.

Hill Street residents may see an increase in construction vehicles using Hill Street, where possible, this will be avoided.

During this work there will be no pedestrian access across Bridge Street from one side of the Lake Forbes walkway to the other side.

Traffic changes

For the safety of motorists and workers there will be some temporary traffic changes during this work.
