



Existing Riverbank Forest

A number of vegetation management strategies will be implemented over the course of the project. These include:

- Restoration, regeneration and rehabilitation of areas of native vegetation.
- Preparation of an Urban Design and Landscape Plan in consultation with relevant stakeholders.
- Monitoring and control of weed populations that establish in disturbed areas.
- Fencing and protection of endangered ecological communities identified to be retained and protected.
- Minimising disturbance to stream banks and streambeds.

In addition to these requirements the landscape design will be responsive to the wildlife corridors identified as part of the context review and reinforce where possible these connections through the provision of appropriate planting.
